

Cristiane Tassinari Jigsaw

Cristiano Tassinari weaves an organic relation among his political vision, life experiences and concept of artistic theory.

Moving through sculpture, video art and installation, Tassinari joins the "traditional" painting with an anonymous and generic sign production: he leads a process of deconstruction and reduction of the artistic creation, playing with conventions and mistakes.

"Since the beginning of my work, I have passed through such schemes, aimed by the intentions to negotiate the reciprocal relations. Shifting from photo-paintings to some more conceptual pieces, simple writings or monochromatic ready-mades, I try to call the praxis of artistic creation into question."

The work reveals ambiguous relations and answers, shows the documentation of its self-generation, brings to attention simple daily wares like a reflecting surface, a neon light or sculptures.

The (apparently) different paths bring to the same end, the intention of transfering private emotions to a public area, of spreading the awarness of the universal value of some topics, like death or human frailty.





Shining plant (with luminescent paint), 2008, plant, intermittent electric light, luminescent paint



















View into, 2009, 120 x 110 x 30, cm oil on canvas, wood
